## 5. Special Guest: The Honourable George R. Strathy

AGM attendees enjoyed a moving presentation from the Honourable George Strathy, retired Chief Justice of Ontario, on the topic of mental wellness in the workplace.

Remarks highlighted three important suggestions that could help facilitate a culture change;

- Leadership Lead by example to reduce the stigma around mental illness, by continuing to promote open and candid conversations about the causes and treatment of mental illness
- Change the environment move beyond the conversation by changing the environment in which we work to eliminate some of the stressors that harm our mental health, and replace them with healthy and less stressful practices.
- Training and protecting young professionals need to do a better job of mentoring them, teaching them the skills and practices they will need to operate in this challenging and demanding profession, and to protect their mental health.
