When working to advance reconciliation, we take a decolonial approach to setting the foundation of this work together, engaging our minds, bodies, emotions and relationships. Yet there are many normalized workplace interactions that can become re-traumatizing to people by eliminating choice, creating safety and connection for some (but not for others). This two-hour experiential session will help you recognize how trauma shows up interpersonally, and how to apply key principles that allow you to respond in ways that actively resist re-traumatization. Take this session to make trauma-informed approaches the new normal standard of care in your practice.
